We do training by going through the handbook and discussing it, we have conferences throughout the year and offer presentations upon requests.

#### PR Webinar April 2025 Notes

The meeting focused on effective communication within Narcotics Anonymous, emphasizing its importance in maintaining unity and developing group conscience.

Presentations were given on public relations efforts in Minnesota and the Russian-speaking Zonal Forum, highlighting various outreach activities and achievements.

The team also discussed strategies for increasing service participation, shared experiences from different regions, and explored potential applications of AI in their work. Next steps Rich to share presentation materials from the meeting with attendees who request them. Ken to send Rich the updated slideshow from his presentation. Luna to share digital copy of regional pamphlet with Patty.

Attendees to consider participating in the upcoming Northeast Zone Service Symposium and Professional Day event. Ken and team to prepare for the Women's Health Expo for Radio Station KJLH in Southern California. Attendees to review and consider implementing the two annual PR events suggested by NAWs (Service Week and PR Week). Attendees interested in attending the Russian-speaking Zonal Forum's 35th anniversary event to register using the provided QR code or link. Summary Effective Communication in NA Service In the meeting, Ken and Luna discussed the importance of effective communication within the Narcotics Anonymous (NA) service structure. They emphasized the need for honest, open, and straightforward communication among all parties involved to maintain the unity of the NA groups and their continued support and direction. They also highlighted the significance of clear and frequent communication in developing group conscience and ensuring the effectiveness of their services. Ken and Luna stressed the importance of direct responsibility, accountability, and participation in the service structure, and how these elements depend on good communication among the various elements of the fellowship. They also touched upon the role of professionals and the public in their communication efforts, and the need for full and frequent communication to develop an informed group conscience. Narcotics Anonymous Public Relations in Minnesota Patty presents on the public relations efforts of Narcotics Anonymous in Minnesota. She describes their participation in professional conferences, community events, and recovery focused activities. The region focuses on projects like Bridging the Gap, a regional helpline, and a monthly newsletter. They attend annual professional conferences, gay pride festivals, and recovery walks. Patty highlights their use of banners, literature, and new promotional items like backpacks and stickers. She also mentions their Bridging the Gap program, which connects newcomers with NA members, and announces that Minnesota will host the 2026 Midwest Zonal Forum CAR workshop. Russian Zonal Forum PR Update Evgeniy presents an update on the Russian-speaking Zonal Forum's public relations efforts. He reports significant growth in the community, with over 4,000 meetings and 1,000 groups across 290 cities. The PR committee has various roles including coordinators for helplines, websites, and federal agencies. Recent achievements include a large

zonal convention covered by national TV, launching a unified helpline number, creating new public service announcements, and obtaining permission to place NA literature in libraries. Evgeniy also mentions the formation of an IT committee and the development of a brand book for consistent messaging. He invites everyone to the upcoming 35th anniversary celebration and service assembly in June. Russian Organization Growth and AI Applications The team discussed the growth of a Russian organization, with Wilvena sharing her experience of seeing helpline cards in a Moscow pharmacy. Luna shared her region's efforts to increase service participation, including a fellowship development team and a regional pamphlet. Wilvena also mentioned a service symposium happening in the northeast zone. Ken shared his involvement in a women's health expo for a radio station, and the team discussed peer recovery specialists and their role in treatment facilities. The conversation ended with discussions on AI applications, including a resume service and AI actors for presentations.
