#### Report

We had our first ad hoc meeting regarding NA literature available on inmate tablets on July 13th. We discussed what we know now - different institutions use different apps, and that the answer isn't straightforward across the board. At least for some of the apps, including Securus and Getting Out (GTL), only the Basic Text is available.

In the facilities I had knowledge of, the Basic Text was free and books didn't require the paid subscription fee that's necessary to access other apps. Some of us have heard otherwise, but in these institutions it isn't possible to download more literature in that library or for a loved one to purchase it digitally for the inmates.

Cheryl had reached out to a member in another state who had participated in expanding literature access in institutions using the Edovo and/or Cypherworx apps. There are a few institutions in Wisconsin that have access to the Edovo app, attached are documents that list the institutions and the content available on them. In the meeting we discussed the possibility of expanding access in Wisconsin—Dezz has a contact at NAWS who may be able to reach out to someone at the WI Department of Corrections about this.

In the interim, we're going to compile a list of all the institutions in WI and contacts for whomever handles their tablets, so that we can find out what apps they use and what the inmates there have access to. We won't be reaching out yet, just creating the list for now, and we'll also begin a list with all the apps inmates use here and their contents. RCMs, if you know or can get the points of contact for whomever would handle the tablets in the institutions in your area, please email them to me at erikaw9999@yahoo.com. I put the tentative date for the next meeting as Tuesday, September 9th at 6pm Central Time unless it doesn't work for anyone else who wants to participate.
