Hello family,

At this point, there is a total balance in our bank account of \$23,744.72 in the account and as stated in the policy we should have \$15,698.00 in the account to cover prudent reserves including a working reserve of \$3,500. This leaves us with \$8,046.72 over what policy states as the Prudent reserve. Minus the 5% for both MZF domination and the NAWS donation will leave us with \$7,242.05 over prudent reserve.

I will be sending a donation to both MZF and NAWS for \$402.33 each.

With that being said...

\$735.00 was deposited last cycle.

A check for \$550.00 to Becky S. for the hospitality room at WSNAC has cleared.

A check to Dezzz G. for \$267.41 has cleared for MZF reimbursement.

Checks to MZF and NAWS from last cycle have cleared for \$452.28 each

There was a \$4.00 service fee from Associated Bank.

Report

IT suffered a huge loss with the unexpected death of Mike R, who was a really valuable and dedicated member of IT. Thankfully Mike himself had pushed for people to learn the technical duties of different positions, so on hearing the sad news we were able to quickly pivot and make sure essential responsibilities were covered until the subcommittee meeting. At the IT Subcommittee meeting we confirmed positions. Thank you to everyone who stepped up! Some positions are filled on a temporary basis and we could really need more volunteers for positions, AND to learn the various technical responsibilities in case of emergency where we might again need to cover duties. Currently, Deb is Chair and BMLT Coordinator, Jane is CoChair, Events Administrator, Website Coordinator, and Training Coordinator, Erin is Helpline Coordinator. Dezzz is Email Accounts Administrator. And of course Tim is our special worker, who we have hired to provide the web hosting and manage the website. Secretary is open.

The problem with the reports going out has been resolved. A change to the SMTP protocol thanks to the government regulations is why the problem suddenly started occurring. Tim, Jane and Drew are looking into whether changing to IMAP would be more robust.

Tim reported that we REALLY need to become a 501.c3. Our IT needs are pushing the limits of what we can do using free technology, however there are many benefits and cost reductions available to non-profits which would really help. (These do not violate our Traditions, when the same offer is available to any non-profit.) Among others, you can look at what Microsoft offers at <https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/nonprofits/microsoft-365> Two of our needs that continue to increase are email resources and data storage.

WRSC has not yet approved Tim's contract for 2026. That will need to be on the topic board. One question that had been raised in September was whether he would be willing to roll over support hours into the following year in the event that we didn't use our contracted 15 hours of support in a year. He said he could not do that because the billing amount per hour might increase, however if there are extra hours left at the end of a year h could reduce the amount of money needed for the following year by the amount those hours would have cost in the current year.
